Purpose/educational value of visit:
 An extension of the football option in Sport and Enrichment. A chance for the students to see the skills they have been learning put to use in a professional football match. An opportunity for students to experience a live sporting event, which many of the students do not have the chance to do despite them following the sport on television. To help establish links with a sports club to enable the school to achieve the School Games Mark Award at Gold level. Adam has already started making links with Hull City and attending matches will strengthen this connection. Welburn Hall has links with a school in Kenya, with the college students writing letters to the students in Kenya. During the evening there will be African entertainment giving our students a taste of the culture of their new penpals, and as the match is to be screened throughout Africa, it will give some of the students something in common to talk about in their letters. This is an opportunity for our students to have a multicultural experience which we don't often have due to our locality. It will show our students the differences in the chances our footballers get compared to their African counterparts and also the differences and similarities between people from different cultures.
