I would like to take this opportunity to express my thanks to all parents, carers, current and past staff who have supported me during my six years at Welburn Hall School. My lasting memories are not only of collapsed curriculum days with themes like WWII, Queen Elizabeth's birthday, Mardi Gras with the steel pan band and pancake races, but also the small but significant steps of progress which my pupils have made during their time in KS2. I have enjoyed watching those children mature as they have moved up the school and it has been great having the opportunity to teach them on Friday morning's Forest School sessions.

I would like to thank my wonderful team of teaching assistants who have supported me over the years and helped me deliver sessions which motivate the children, from dressing up as lifeboat men and police officers, having lunch on a steam train, visiting a mosque, coping with visiting creatures from owls to puppies, spiders to snakes...even if they were frightened of them!... and even going down slides at Twiggy's!

A big thank you to Sue Price for stepping into my shoes and for all her work with the KS2 group.
