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### Our Core Purpose

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### Parents' Agreement

#### We ask that parents and carers:

- Support the school policies and guidelines for behaviour, illness, anti-bullying, E-Safety etc
- Ensure that your child arrives at school on time and appropriately dressed.
- Notify school of all absences either by letter or by telephone.
- Attend meetings that involve your child.
- Keep the school informed of any relevant changes in family circumstances.
- Keep the school informed of any concerns or problems that may affect your child's work or behaviour.
- Maintain regular communication with the school through home/school diaries, telephone calls and visits to the school.
- Ensure that school has an **up to date contact number** and an emergency contact number so that you can be contacted should the need arise. If the contact number is a mobile number then mobiles need to be switched on!
- Ensure that your child is fit and well enough to attend school, referring to our illness procedure.

#### We require pupils to:

- Attend school and be on time.
- Talk to an adult if they are unhappy about something.
- Be caring and considerate of others.
- Have respect for the school building, equipment and the school environment.

#### The School and House will:

- Support pupils to achieve their full potential.
- Provide a broad, balanced, interesting and relevant curriculum appropriate to your child's needs.
- Provide a safe environment and high level of care to look after the wellbeing of your child.
- Keep you fully informed of your child's progress via meetings, reports, letters and the home/school diary.
- Set challenging targets for your child to achieve.
- Promote high standards of behaviour where your child will learn to build good relationships.
- Try to be open and welcoming at all times and offer opportunities for you to become involved in the life of the school.
- Provide regular information about your child's school life through newsletters and home school diaries.

- The House (where appropriate) will work in partnership with the school to extend your child's education by providing a quality educational experience with meaningful leisure and recreational activities in a warm, caring and supportive environment.

**Together we will:**

- Ensure your child's safety, happiness and general well being.
- Highlight and celebrate the success and achievement of every child.
- Work together to develop every child so that he/she can reach his/her full potential in an atmosphere of positive encouragement.
- Contribute to communication between School, the House and home.
