The prize draws will take place on the last week of term.



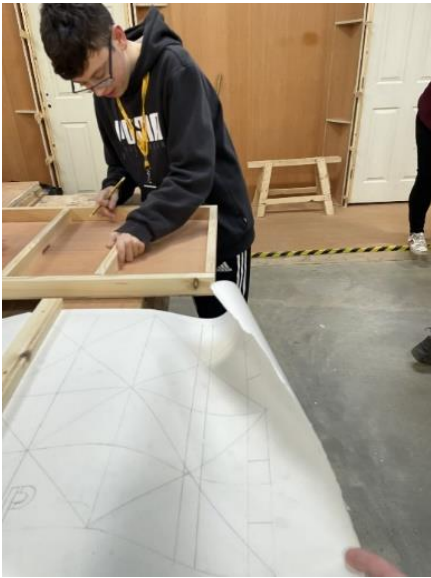
