

Maths

- Four operation + - \times \div
- Geometry - 2D & 3D shapes property and positions, angles and position
- Statistics - creating and understanding various tables, charts to represent information. Using simple step problems to solve using data.

English

Reading: As part of a whole class decision, we will be reading Harry Potter and the Philosopher Stone which we are all excited about. Further to embed our comprehension skills a text will be focused on weekly covering various genres.

Writing: to recognise stories from other cultures and to make connection of similarities and difference. We look closely at character behaviour and story settings. Creating poster informational text and then the impact of poetry on the reader.

Speaking and listening: this is a skill taught discretely and directly throughout sessions where open questions and discussion are encouraged. Listening is recognised through appropriate response and recall.

Science

- Carry out investigation lead by the children interest of wanting to explore, where predictions are made, and a method is followed resulting in recording our finding and bring out understanding to a conclusion.
