Open Awards Functional Skills Maths

We will start the term focussing on sequencing numbers, rounding, the four operations and BIDMAS. After October half-term we will move onto fractions and decimals, and we will also start the 'shape, space and measure unit' with mathematical problems around weight, capacity, temperature and length.

English

Open Awards Functional Skills English

In our first term we will continue to focus on preparation for the English Functional Skills exams. We will practice reading and spelling in our phonics sessions, we will complete writing tasks with real world scenarios, and will regularly practice our speaking and listening skills. We will also be reading Holes by Louis Sachar.

Science

OCR Entry Level Science

For our first term, we will focus on biology. We will start by looking at living things and biological processes that define an organism. We will then learn about the respiratory system and how it functions, and finally the nervous system, the senses we can decipher and the responses our body makes.

OCR Entry Level Geography
