

Maths

In maths, we will focus on mental arithmetic and calculation. Students will continue to develop their multiplication, times tables, addition and subtraction. Real life examples will be utilised wherever possible, and exam skills will be developed throughout.

English

At the beginning of Autumn term, we will read the Iron Man by Ted Hughes. We will discuss moral and ethical questions relating to the text, creatively explore different narrative avenues, and complete reading comprehension and SPaG activities. Through this story, we will also explore different writing styles, including stories and newspaper articles. Following on from the Iron Man we will read the BFG by Roald Dahl. We will complete character studies, discuss human rights, creatively re-structure chapters and revisit our phonics knowledge!

ICT

At the beginning of Autumn term, the focus will be on Excel and spreadsheets. Students will create numerical graphics, locate information in spreadsheets, alter spreadsheets and create spreadsheets from scratch. The students will then move on to bias and information accuracy. Students will identify appropriate sources of information and will use these sources to create hyperlinks in PowerPoint.

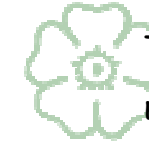
