Each class has their own farm time and will soon be able to say hi!




















Miss Young's class have used their creative art time to produce a brilliant display in honour of Remembrance Sunday.











Miss Leetham's class have had a fun filled few days back at school!


They've really enjoyed exploring their new sensory light box this week. As well as visits to the farm to meet the new goats, lots of happy jumping in PE and of course making friends.






Wellbeing & Safeguarding

Family Lives provides targeted early intervention and crisis support to families who are struggling.

They assist families with such things as family breakdown, challenging relationships and behaviour, debt, and emotional and mental wellbeing. They are a volunteer-led organisation, who work alongside their dedicated staff team.

Formerly known as Parentline Plus, they aim to support families in a number of ways:

- **Confidential helpline**: Call on **0808 800 2222** for emotional support, information, advice and guidance on any aspect of parenting and family life. Helpline opening hours: Monday to Friday 9am to 9pm Weekends 10am to 3pm.
- Live online chat open Monday to Friday between 10.30am to 9pm. Contact them about any family or parenting issue.
- Online parenting courses to get advice and learn new skills, with helpful techniques and ideas in your own home/time. Available courses include: Parents Together, Let's Play, Coping with Teens, A New Baby in the Family, Bringing up Confident Children and many more.
- **Parenting advice videos** <u>Parentchannel.tv</u> is a free video service with 200 videos addressing day-to-day questions and concerns spanning wellbeing, behaviour and learning.
- Advice on all aspects of family life with everything from bonding with your new baby, dealing with tantrums, positive discipline, mental health, bullying, communicating with teens and divorce and separation.
