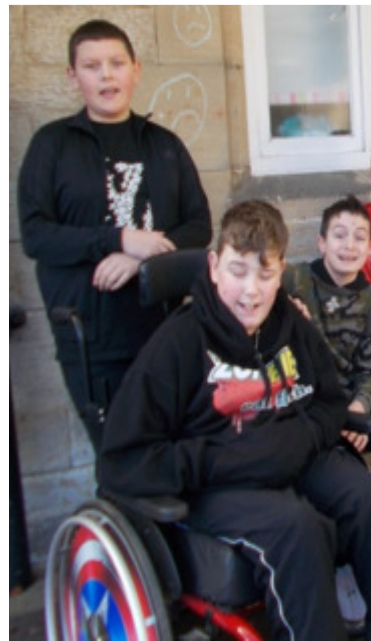
Friday 11th December
