



Miss Swaddle's class made bird feeders so that they can watch all the many and lovely birds that we have on our grounds at Welburn.













In Christina's science class, students have been learning all about the photovoltaic effect and the effects of light intensity on electrical output.

They tested this effect in groups with mini solar panels and voltmeters, and then recorded their excellent results in line graphs! The learners all worked exceptionally well in their teams!
























As part of their Life Skills accreditation, learners complete a unit on household cleaning and using products safely.
