Rebound Therapy is a specific methodology that uses trampoline for therapeutic exercise.

Rebound Therapy helps in many ways, but specifically with movement, promoting balance/relaxation, supports an increase or decrease in muscle tone as required, assists with sensory integration, improves fitness/exercise tolerance and can help communication skills. Perhaps most importantly, our learners really enjoy it!

In school sessions are delivered by a qualified Rebound Therapist. We follow the Winstrada program of Rebound Therapy from grades 1-10.

Here's Mr Kaufman's class, who are currently working towards their Grade 2 and all doing very well! All of our Pre-Formal and Semi-Formal classes will do regular Rebound Therapy sessions on a rota. Learners are also awarded certificates for passing their grades.
