Welburn Hall Home School Association generates funds for things that we want at school that are not provided for by the local authority.
















Our York College Construction group have been busy building structures using only drinking straws and masking tape.

Welibeing in Mind Team - We are a team of NHS staff working with school staff providing edvice, support and training on wellbeing issues as well as forming a link between the school and other services supporting young people. This work includes direct support for young people experiencing mild to moderate difficulties such as enxiety and low mood. Support to utilize online resources and develop skills as well as classroom-based education sessions in conjunction with the school's pastoral team to improve knowledge and understanding about wellbeing.

Autism Specialist Award

Welburn Hall School is currently undertaking the Autism Specialist Award, an accreditation programme run by the National Autistic Society.

This is the UK's only autism-specific, quality assurance programme, providing

support and development for organisations, such as ours, who provide services to autistic people. Achieving accreditation proves that we are committed to understanding autism and setting the standard for autism practice.

Welburn Hall is keen to keep parents/carers updated on our progress towards accreditation and since September, staff have taken part in:

- In-house Autistic Spectrum Disorder (ASD) training; focusing on comorbidity and Pathological Demand Avoidance
- Self-Awareness Programme helping our students to explore self-awareness and understanding personal needs
- ASD friendly classrooms looking at classroom best practice and utilising the most useful/effective tools
- Zones of Regulation Training a whole school initiative

Autism Accreditation is an internationally recognised quality standard and, with over 30 years of accreditation expertise, the National Autistic Society oversee the world's longest running programme of its kind.
