Would you like to know more about Supported Internships?

A Supported Internship is a work-based study programme for 16- to 24-year-olds with special educational needs and disabilities, who have an EHCP.

Internships are unpaid and last for 12 months. Young people are enrolled with a training provider, but spend most of their time a workplace setting.

An internship aims to help participants develop their work skills and gain valuable experience, with the hope of gaining paid employment.

To give parents/carers more information about this scheme, North Yorkshire Council is leading a series of brief (45min) **online sessions to explain all about them.**

Each session will focus on provision within a particular area of North Yorkshire and feature Supported Internship Providers from that area.

Rebound Therapy - Consent

Rebound Therapy is about using the trampoline for the benefit of students with a wide range of disabilities. It is used to enhance movement patterns, develop and promote motor skills, body awareness, balance, coordination, and communication.

It's a highly enjoyable activity and the sensory feedback students acquire helps them with regulation, ready for learning.

You may have consented before, but this was for the outdoor trampolines – we have new ones for indoor and therefore need parental consent for your child to take part. We realise not all of our students are able to do it.

Rebound Therapy consent forms were sent home in bags before the Easter holidays – please get them back to us as a matter of urgency.
