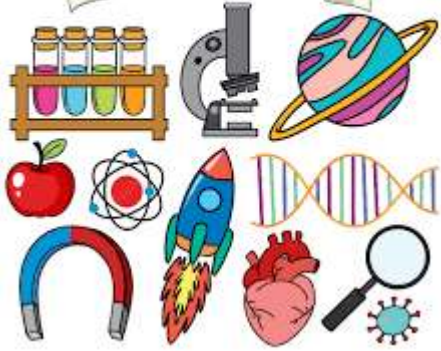

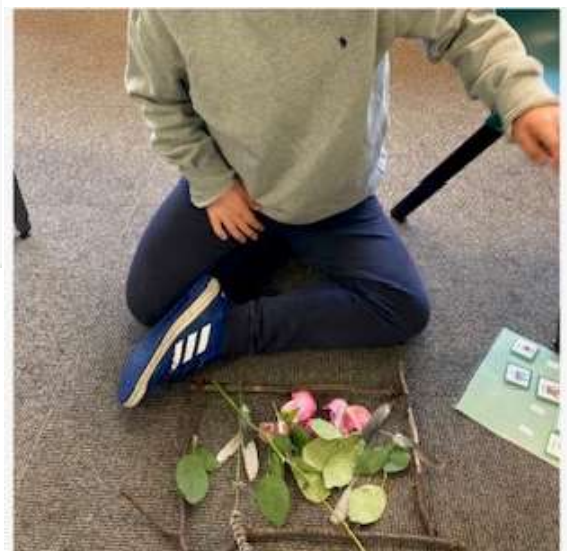

### Latest Guidance for Covid infections

Last week we experienced a number covid infections within school and wanted to update parents. Current guidance from The Department of Education says that children and young people aged 18 and under who test positive for COVID-19:

should stay at home and avoid contact with other people for three days

We respectfully request that students with a high temperature or are unwell do not come into school.

### Flu vaccinations

Flu immunisation is being offered to all students up to and including Year 11. Vaccinations will take place at Welburn **Monday 2 October**

We will shortly be sending you a consent form link – obviously this must be completed before your child can be immunised.

The vaccine is administered either by nasal spray or injection.

Children and young people who have the flu vaccine are less likely to pass the virus on to friends and family, especially those who may be at greater risk from flu, such as young babies, elderly people or friends and relatives with a serious health condition.

### Consent forms

Many thanks to those of you who have returned your child's consent/starter pack forms – we've now updated our records. There are a handful of forms that have still not been returned. We really must have up-to-date information for your child – so please return any outstanding forms as a matter of urgency. By all means call the school if you need replacements.

### Reviews
