
Chocolate Enterprise Challenge




On Monday morning our KS4/KS5 Formal students all took part in a Chocolate Enterprise Challenge.


The students were arranged into teams, and they had to assign different job roles to team members. Students had to all work together to design a completely new box of chocolates.

The results are some gorgeous, hand coloured, 2024 calendars and fun, doggy bandanas!


One student would like to start his own small business on a Thursday afternoon during work experience; he will be creating dog inspired crafts - watch this space!!!
