To gain Accreditation Welburn Hall School has to meet a standard of excellence and follow a framework for continuous self-examination and development.

We must say a sincere thank you to all the parents who gave their views to the National Autistic Society during our assessment. We very much value your feedback and appreciate the input that our parents give.

The National Autistic Society is the UK's leading charity for autistic people and their Autism Specialist Award is a quality assurance programme set up by the society in 1992 to improve the support available to autistic people in organisations throughout the UK.

The last stage of this process is Accredited Advanced and Welburn Hall School will continue to strive in order to achieve this.


