


Mrs Foy's College art group painted landscape/weather pictures, inspired by photographs taken on her journey to work last Friday.

We are working to move from 'Aspiring' to 'Accredited'. It's about ensuring that our students with autism have the very best provision and our staff have the most up-to-date knowledge and training. Our eventual aim is to reach 'Advanced' level and we will continue working hard to achieve this.

As part of this next stage the National Autism Society is asking parents of children with autism to please complete a short questionnaire. So, if you have a spare five minutes, it is quick and easy and we would appreciate your time and input.

We know that some of our students may not have a formal Autism diagnosis. If you suspect your child has a need that is best supported with ASD strategies, you are also invited to complete the questionnaire.
