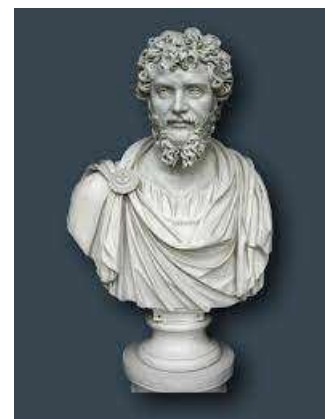




Mrs Clapton's Class are studying the Romans
